Stonewall Park Pool

Rules and Regulations

All Federal, State, and City laws and policies must be adhered to while on the park grounds.

- 1) Prices posted are non-negotiable and apply to everyone.
- 2) Do not attempt to touch, reach into, or play with the cash registers.
- 3) **No** smoking within the pool enclosure.
- 4) Do not enter restricted areas.
- 5) **All** children under 11 years must be accompanied by a paying adult. 16 years or older.
- 6) **All** children 5 and under must be within arm's reach of an adult at all times.
- 7) **All** children over 6 years must use the appropriate locker room.
- 8) Large groups must maintain a 10:1 ratio of participants and chaperons.
- 9) **No** Horseplay (running, pushing, dunking) within the pool enclosure.
- 10) Patrons must refrain from holding or touching each other's head, neck, and shoulders.
- 11) **No** ball playing or throwing of any items.
- 12) **No** playing with showers, bathroom fixtures, foot sprays, hoses, skimmers, poles, and equipment.
- 13) **No** searching through lockers.
- 14) **No** screaming or profanity.
- 15) **Alcohol is prohibited in all City Parks.**
- 16) **No** chewing gum or other sticky candy.
- 17) **All** food and drink must be kept away from the edge of the pool.
- 18) **No** sitting or standing on top of picnic tables.
- 19) **No** climbing or standing on the handicap railing.
- 20) **No** rough play in the ramp area.
- 21) **Do not** enter the brick walkway beside the access ramp.
- 22) Non-swimmers must stay in water where they can touch the bottom of the pool.
- 23) Children wearing life jackets must be accompanied by an adult while in the water.
- 24) **All** life jackets must be self-supporting; they must have an area where the child sits or must fasten between the legs of the child. (NO ARM FLOATIES)
- 25) Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers
- 26) Masks, goggles, and diving toys are permitted at the discretion of the management
- 27) **No** inflatable toys or water guns.
- 28) **Bathing suits are required. No clothing in the pool.** Mesh athletic shorts are acceptable on men. Board shorts are acceptable on men and women.
- 29) **No** loitering around the fence or entrance to the pool.
- 30) **No** talking to or distracting lifeguards while they are in the stand.
- 31) Only staff may park on the lower level and use the side entrance.
- 32) **Only** service animals are allowed within the pool enclosure.
- 33) **No** spitting or blowing ones nose into or near the pool.
- 34) **All** patrons must collect their own trash and place it in the proper receptacle.
- 35) **All** patrons are responsible for their own belongings. Items in the pool Lost-and-Found will be held for one week, after which items will be donated.
- 36) Persons with open wounds or eye/ear/mouth discharge are not permitted in the pool.
- 37) **All** patrons must leave the pool enclosure in the event of thunder or lightening.
- 38) **No** diving except from the diving board in the diving well.
- 40) **Pool staff has discretion of what behavior is appropriate for patron safety.**

Stonewall Park Pool

Rules and Regulations

SLIDE RULES (open unless manager deems it unsafe)

- 1) Riders must be 48 inches or taller.
- 2) Riders must be able to swim.
- 3) One person is permitted at a time. Riders must wait for the person in front of them to reach the ladder before sliding.
- 4) Always use the ladder closest to the slide. Do not swim across the well or into the lap swim area.
- 5) No t-shirts, goggles, rafts, or toys on the slide.
- 6) Rider must be seated or laying on their back.
- 7) Feet First entry ONLY.
- 8) No stopping in the slide.

DIVING BOARD RULES (open unless manager deems it unsafe)

- 1) One person is permitted at a time. Patrons must wait for the person in front of them to reach the ladder before leaving the board.
- 2) Patrons must leave the board facing forward and cannot jump sideways.
- 3) Always use the ladder closest to the board. Do not swim across the well or into the lap swim area.
- 4) Patrons are allowed only one bounce on the board.
- 5) No t-shirts, goggles, rafts, or toys on the board.
- 6) No adjusting the diving board.
- 7) Throwing items to patrons as they leave the diving board is permitted at management's discretion.

BABY POOL RULES (open unless manager deems it unsafe)

- 1) **Baby Pool is for patrons 5 and under ONLY (even during break)**
- 2) All children under 5 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 3) Baby pool gate must be kept closed at all times.
- 4) Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers.
- 5) No climbing on top of whale.
- 6) Large-sized rafts or toys are prohibited.
- 7) Rough play in the baby pool is prohibited.

**Patrons found in violation of these rules can be denied usage of the pool.
Pool staff has discretion of what behavior is appropriate for patron safety.**
