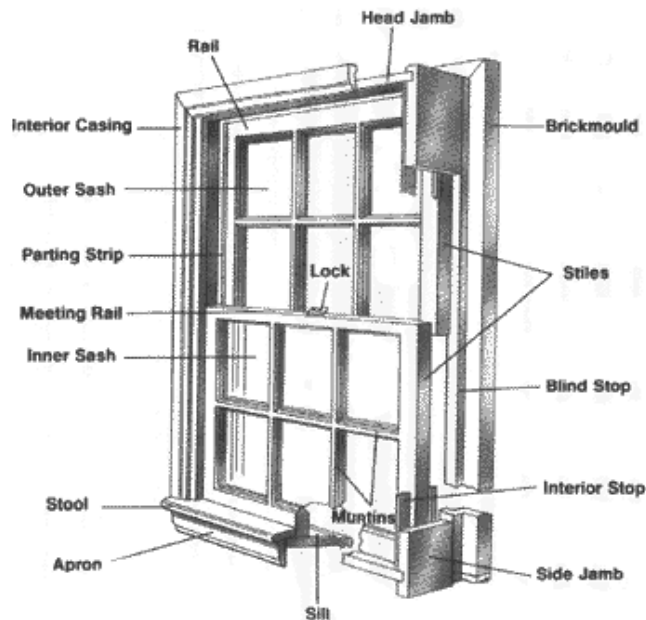


HISTORIC DISTRICT WINDOW GUIDELINES

Anatomy of a Window



New Historic District Window Policy

- Provide photo documentation of all existing windows in detail.
- Provide dimension and profiles of all existing window parts.
- Exterior storm windows should be of solid glass. If painted it should match the window frame.
- If changing inappropriate windows that have been changed before, they need to come before the Architectural Review Board and be more appropriate and more historically accurate to the structure.
- Newly proposed windows must match the dimension, profile, and appearance of the original windows.
- They may use substitute materials but the proposed window must have the same dimension, profile and appearance of the original window.
- New construction would have to match those window types that would be approved within the historic district area. Including, matching the dimension, profile appearance of appropriate historic windows.
